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One Day Online Autodesk Civil 3D Overview Prospectus

This basic 1-day course is aimed at giving delegates a general overview of Autodesk Civil 3D and introduces the benefits of the UKIE Country Kit. Aimed at managers who want to know what all the fuss is about, but also suitable for CAD Users who wish to find their feet before attending an essentials course.

The course runs over 1-day. Delegates are expected to be online between 9:30am and 4:30pm with a 45-minute lunch break and regular comfort breaks.

Civil 3D 2018, 2019, 2020 or 2021 will need to be installed, and running, on your computer. The UKIE Country Kit is also a requirement.

A wired, reliable, internet connection is recommended. Dual screens are also a recommendation.

Registered delegates will be contacted before the course and will be invited to a half hour 'pre-course' setup session to ensure everything is in place before the day. (this setup session is typically organised during the week prior to the course).
